Matthew 16 - Study Notes 2/1/23

Matthew 16:1-4 What did the religious leaders want to do to Jesus in the passage? What did they ask him for?
Matthew 12:38-40 - sign of Jonah Last withdrawal before journey toward Jerusalem
Matthew 16:5-12 Jesus used this travel time to teach the disciples about this encounter. Were they tracking with Jesus at first? V 7 What conclusion did the disciples come up with after discussing?
"Yeast" was a common symbol for evil and could therefore be applied to different kinds of wickedness
What was Jesus' reaction to their answer?
V 11 Instead of explaining the meaning of his metaphor of the yeast, Jesus repeats it. Why do you think he did this?
Matthew 16:13-16 Caesarea Philipi - 25 miles north of the sea of galilee Built by Herod Phillip: center of worship of Baal, then of the god Pan, and then Ceasar known to be the source of the Jordan river, making it highly significant to the Jews - this place was symbolically beneath the shadow of the ancient gods
V 13 What question does Jesus first ask the disciples?
"Son of Man" - theologically important title - Occurs 81 times in the gospels and was Jesus preferred title for himself V 14 Who did the disiciples say people thought he was? - John the Baptist, Elijah, Jeremiah and/or another prophet
V 15 Jesus then most importantly asked themWho do YOU think I am?

V 16 Who answered for the group and what was his response? All three gospels include this confession Matt 16:16Mark 8:29 Luke 9:20
Matthew 16:17-20 Jesus calls him Simon Bar-Jonah (Simon Peter was the son of a man named Jonah)
Jesus said Peter was blessed because
V 18 Peter's name is a play on words in two languages. Greek = Petros, petra means "rock" Aramaic = Cephas, also meaning rock.
V 19 I will build my church on what? What shall not prevail or overcome it?
Matthew 16:21-23 V 21 What did Jesus begin to show the disciples?
V22 What did Peter's reaction reveal?
V23 Jesus says to Peter "Get behind me Satan" versus when Jesus says to devil in 4:10 "Begone Satan"
Matthew 16:24-28 V 24 - Jesus says there is 3 things which people must be prepared to live a christian life: 1. Deny themselves - 2. Take up a cross - 3. Follow Jesus Christ -
V 25 - Similar teaching back in Matt 10:38-39 V 26 - 2 great questions to ask on a daily basis V 27 inevitable judgement for all people V 28 some would see the Spirit descend on Pentecost, Gentiles and Jews combined, gospel spread beyond Israel.
