“Justification” is the declaring of a person to be just or righteous.

“Salvation” is deliverance from the power and effects of sin and entrance into God's presence

10 We were enemies and we were reconciled to God

“Reconciliation” means a broken relationship was healed.

11 We rejoice . . . we have now received reconciliation
