Sunday, September 10th LifeGroup Discussion Guide Did God Really Say: Truth & Lies

MY STORY:

- 1. Has someone ever mistaken you to be someone else? (share any funny or serious stories)
- 2. How would you define the word truth?
- 3. How have you heard others define truth?

DIGGING DEEPER

- 1. Read Luke Genesis 2:15-17 What sticks out to you?
- 2. From the beginning of creation God expected obedience and acceptance of his Word as absolute Truth. Would you say you obey the Word of God, or do you only obey parts of it?

- 3. We read that the truth will set you free (John 8:32). To know the truth, you must abide in His word. What does your daily devotion time look like? Do you read your Bible daily?
- 4. The enemy loves to whisper in our ears "did God really say" think of a time where the enemy said "did God really say" to you. Share that time if you want and share how you overcame/overcome the lies of the enemy.
- 5. God was specific when telling Adam and Eve that they shouldn't even "touch" the fruit on the tree. Have you noticed yourself getting closer and closer to a certain sin? How do you flee from temptation?

TAKING IT HOME

- 1. What are some lies you are believing today?
- 2. Satan makes a claim in the garden "you will be like God" He still tempts us with that today. Telling us we can be our own Gods. Is there an area in your life that you need to give back to God? Is there sin in your life that you need to repent of and receive God's grace?
- 3. Read John 14:6 as a reminder that Jesus is the source of all truth. This truth has saving significance. Jesus has done for us what we are incapable of doing for ourselves.
