Is the kingdom of God the victim of violence and force? Or does the kingdom of God advance through violence?

- v. 13-15 John's ministry was prophesied in the Old Testament Malachi 4:5
- v. 16-17 Jesus likens the responses to John and Jesus with an illustration.
- v. 18-19 In the same way, people "didn't get" John. They "didn't get" Jesus.

But wisdom is justified by her children.

- v. 25 What things were hidden from the wise and prudent?
- v. 27 Jesus says He and the Father know each other. Who else knows the Father?
 - v. 28-30 Jesus invites everyone to come to Him to receive that revelation. what is the result of the revelation?

The kingdom of God:

Offers itself sacrificially Seeks to serve Prioritizes love Is willing to die Hopes in the resurrection
