Passover feast was to commemorate the greatest event in Israel's history, the deliverance of Israel from slavery in Egypt:



- A sacrificial lamb
- Karpas (lettuce) dipped in salt water
- Maror - collection of bitter herbs
- Charoset (apples, dates, pomegranates, nuts)
- 4 cups of wine reminders of the 4 promises of Exodus:6:6-7
Jesus is purposefully putting himself in the right place (inside the city walls) for the appointed time (his arrest)
The disciples respond with, "Is it I,?"
Judas responds with, "Is it I,?"
What does this difference indicate?
More information from John 13:12-30
What more do we learn here?
 All the symbolism and the ritualistic action of the Passover Feast is pointing to Jesus: Passover Feast was a commemoration of deliverance = Jesus is the great liberator from slavery to fear and sin. Passover lamb was the symbol of safety. It was the blood that kept Israel safe from death in Egypt. = Jesus is our Savior. He came to give safety on the earth and safety in heaven, safety in time and safety in eternity.
The word is a keyword in this scene.
Jesus is speaking of a new relationship between God and humanity.
The cup fulfills all the promises made in Exodus 6:6-7
Hebrews 9 and Luke 22:20
V29 Jesus is still directing them toward even at the very end.
