2. Paul's use of the "diatribe".
3. **Romans 3:1** Question: What is the advantage of being a Jew?
4. **Romans 3:2** Answer: The Jews received God's word.
5. **Romans 3:3-4** Question: If the Jews were unfaithful, does that mean God was unfaithful, too?
Psalm 51:4 Against you, and you alone, have I sinned;
I have done what is evil in your sight.
You will be proved right in what you say,
and your judgment against me is just.
6. **Romans 3:5-8** Questions: (v5) Isn't it unfair for God to punish sinful people since our sin helps people see God's righteousness?
(v7) How can God condemn me as a sinner if my dishonesty highlights his truthfulness and brings him more glory?
-Answer (v6) Of course not! God is righteous in his judgment.

-**Genesis 18:25** Surely you wouldn't do such a thing, destroying the righteous along with the wicked. Why, you would be treating the righteous and the wicked exactly the same! Surely you wouldn't do that! Should not the Judge of all the earth do what is right?"
