A few big ideas to keep in mind:

- 1. Core theme of Ephesians = reconciliation of ethinic groups into one unified people.
- 2. One...Becoming One....Unity....this is the heartbeat of the book.
- 3. This is a book about understanding and living out the gospel of Jesus.

Chapters 1-3 - Theological - know, understand, comprehend Chapters 4-6 - Practical - response, calls to action, respond to revelation

## Verses 1-2

Who wrote this letter? To whom did he write it? Why did he write it? What is his role?

Apostle = Greek word "apostolos" meaning one who\_\_\_\_\_\_. Who did the grace and peace come from? Grace = Greek word is "charis" - Grace always describes\_\_\_\_\_\_. Peace = Greek word is "eirene" The Hebrew word is \_\_\_\_\_\_ and it implies a sense of wholeness, completeness, safety.

This letter unpacks Paul's \_\_\_\_\_\_ which in Greek means "apocalypsis" Apocalypse = Revelation = Transformation - Acts 9:1-9 story

Galatians 1:15-16 Ephesians 3:3-5 Heaven comes down to earth = the overlap is an apocalypse (heaven realities revealed on earth)

## V 3 - 14 - longest verse in the Greek NT

- Lyrical song of \_\_\_\_\_
- Both a prayer and a \_\_\_\_\_
- Poetic = short, dense and \_\_\_\_\_
- Cascade of dense beautiful ideas that move us toward an \_\_\_\_\_\_

Paul's Trinitarian experience of God lies behind everything. God/Father (<u>1:3–6</u>), Son (<u>vv. 7–12</u>), and Holy Spirit (<u>vv. 13–14</u>); note that each of these concludes with "to the praise of his glorious grace"; "for/to the praise of his glory."
