GRIEVE HOLY SPIRIT

³⁰ And do not bring **sorrow** to **God's Holy Spirit** by the **way you LIVE**. Remember, he has identified you as his own, guaranteeing that you will be saved on the day of redemption.

LIVE - ³¹ Get rid of all bitterness, rage, anger, harsh words, and slander, as well as all types of evil behavior.

LIVE LIKE - ³² Instead, be kind to each other, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, just as God through Christ has forgiven you.

- 1. Believers cause the Holy Spirit grief when they **ignore his presence**, **inner voice or leading**. (Ro 8:5-17 | Gal 5:16-25)
 - a. Also, through **unwholesome talk** (foul or abusive language) & through **hurtful or violent emotion or behavior** (v.31)
- 2. Grieving Holy Spirit leads to a person resisting Holy Spirit (Acts 7:51)
 - a. Leads to a person putting out Holy Spirit fire in their life (1 Th 5:19)
 - b. Leads to insulting Holy Spirit (Heb 10:29)
 - c. Leads to **blasphemy against the Holy Spirit** for which there is no forgiveness (Mat 12:31)

The Process | Grieving leads to Resisting leads to Putting out the fire to insulting to blasphemy
